The eastern part of the Democratic Republic of Congo is characterized by an alarming and complex humanitarian situation, due to armed conflicts in the North Kivu and South Kivu provinces, population displacement to areas considered safe, the presence of epidemics such as cholera, Ebola virus hemorrhagic fever, and other diseases linked to poor hand hygiene like dysentery and typhoid fever. On top of that, natural disasters and chronic poverty further increase the vulnerability of the population in the region. This situation requires special attention from all humanitarian actors in order to reduce its severity and also improve the living conditions of people in difficult circumstances. This action is part of a framework of consultation and collaboration between different partners in the region, aiming to respond to a humanitarian emergency. The general objective of the action is based on improving the living conditions access to drinking water, sanitation, and hygiene for the population, including women, girls, men, and boys who have returned after being displaced. The project aims to meet the immediate WASH needs of 2,000 households, including women, men, girls, and boys, in the city of Goma, neighborhoods: Katoyi, Kasika, Mabanga, Kiziba, Kilijiwe, to reduce the risk of waterborne diseases among the population. The project will also promote safe access to sanitation facilities and improve hygiene conditions. Additionally, the project will work toward the overall improvement of sanitary conditions in the return areas of Katoyi, Kasika, Mabanga, Kiziba, and Kilijiwe, in the Karisimbi commune, city of Goma, North Kivu, Democratic Republic of the Congo..

A. IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD KATOYI

The water filtration activity is carried out in the city of Goma, Katoyi neighborhood, where the team from the organization PALPER ONG, in partnership with the organization CLEAN WATER HELP, raised awareness among the population about the fight against waterborne diseases, installed filters for drinking water treatment, and explained their use to combat diseases such as cholera, typhoid, and amoebic dysentery. In this context, we selected five families, or 5 households, for one filter, meaning 5 households, each with 5 people. So one filter provides drinking water for 25 people coming from 5 households. We started this approach to promote peace and peaceful coexistence among different communities in the North Kivu province, long plagued by war and armed conflicts, and to fight sexual and related violence. On the topic, we understood that with this project, the filters will produce drinking water, which in turn will be a source of peace in the region weakened by war and armed conflicts..

B. IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD KASIKA

The water filtration activity took place in the city of Goma, Kasika neighborhood, where the team from the organization PALPER ONG, in partnership with the organization CLEAN WATER HELP, worked on raising awareness among the population about fighting waterborne diseases, installing filters for drinking water treatment, and teaching how to use them to combat waterborne diseases such as cholera, typhoid, and amoebic dysentery. In this context, we selected five families or five households for a single filter. So, five households, and in each household there are five people. That is to say, one filter provides drinking water for 25 people from five households. We started this approach to promote peace and peaceful coexistence among different communities in the North Kivu province, which has long been devastated by war and armed conflicts, and to fight against sexual and gender-based violence, we understood that with this project, the filters will produce drinking water, which in turn will be a source of Peace in the region weakened by war and armed conflicts.

C. IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD KIZIBA

The water filtration activity took place in the city of Goma, KIZIBA neighborhood, where the team from the organization PALPER ONG, in partnership with the organization CLEAN WATER HELP, carried out awareness campaigns with the local population about fighting waterborne diseases, installed water filters for safe drinking water, and taught people how to use them to fight diseases like cholera, typhoid, and amoebic dysentery. As part of this, we selected five families or 5 households for a single filter, meaning 5 households with 5 people in each household. That means one filter provides safe drinking water for 25 people across 5 households. We started this approach to promote peace and peaceful coexistence among different communities in the North Kivu province, which has long been scarred by war and armed conflicts, and also to fight against sexual violence and gender-based violence, we understood that with this project, the filters will produce drinking water, which in turn will be a source of Peace in the region weakened by war and armed conflicts.

In this context, we selected five families or five households for a single filter. So, five households, and in each household there are five people. That is to say, one filter provides drinking water for 25 people from five households. We started this approach to promote peace and peaceful coexistence among different communities in the North Kivu province, which has long been scarred by war and armed conflicts, and to fight sexual and gender-based violence. That means one filter provides drinking water for the needs of 25 people from 5 households. We initiated this approach to promote peace and peaceful coexistence among different communities in the North Kivu province, long scarred by war and armed conflicts, to fight against sexual and gender-based violence, and we understood that with this project, the filters will produce drinking water, which in turn will be a source of Peace in the region weakened by war and armed conflicts.

CONCLUSION

The water treatment project using Filtration is much more popular with the population in the city of Goma. We only served 5 neighborhoods, and in each neighborhood, we had 5 households, so in total we served 25 households, which is 125 people who today benefit from this water treatment project in the neighborhoods we identified. The needs remain huge because the entire population wants to receive filters to treat water at home. In total, we used \$300 for these project activities in the city of Goma, North Kivu, in the Democratic Republic of Congo.
